Lessons Learned Information Sharing (LLIS.gov) launched on April 19, 2004, which means that Sunday, April 19, 2009, marked our 5-year anniversary. Over the past 5 years, we have expanded the network of emergency response professionals and homeland security officials on *LLIS.gov* to over 48,000 individuals. This dedicated community now has access to nearly 14,000 relevant documents, including over 700 after-action reports from both real-world events and exercises and over 850 original research documents found only on *LLIS.gov*.
